





A **\*record amount\*** raised for the Forget Me Not 'Around the World Challenge' in July, just one of our many enrichment activities.

We are now at the end of the academic year and what a busy year it's been! We must start with a note about our Ofsted inspection, the outcomes of which we are delighted with. We have achieved a grading of 'Good', with 'Outstanding' for the personal development and welfare of our students. There is much to celebrate in the report which can be viewed on both the school's and Ofsted's websites and this is a firm endorsement of 6 years of hard work within the school by staff, students and their families. However, we do not rest on our laurels! We provide our students with an exceptional educational experience and it is only through continued effort that we can further embed our positive values and continue to move the school onwards and upwards.

Last summer our exam results showed that we are the 3rd best performing school across the whole of Kirklees in terms of the progress students make from when they join us in Year 7 to leaving us in Year 11 and nationally, this puts us in the top 7% of schools in the country. Our outgoing Year 11 students this summer have worked extremely hard, as have our staff, who have provided evening, holiday and even Saturday revisions sessions so that students have the best possible opportunity of maximising their potential. We look forward to seeing the fruits of their labours when the results are out in August and we wish our leavers all the best for the future.

A school is about so much more than just exam results and our enrichment programme for students goes from strength to strength, whether this be sporting activities, a school production (as I write this, our rehearsals for Annie are going down a treat with 'test' audiences!) or our work within the community. Miss Taylor, our Teacher of PE and Lisa Jagger, our Enrichment Coordinator, and our students have done some superb work with the care home next door to the school, encouraging the elderly residents to take some gentle, chair-based exercise. The programme really has brought out the nurturing side of our students.

The work with our Trust partners is an important and much valued part of school life and we must give a special mention to Cummins Turbo Technologies who provided a group of students with the challenge of building and then racing a 'Green Power' racing car against other schools. What a great opportunity, and one that I'm sure they will remember for years to come.

There's so much more that I could write about! I am incredibly proud of our school and its achievements. September sees yet another record intake of new Year 7 students and on behalf the school I would like to thank local families for your support and endorsement of our work. On behalf of everyone at NHTS, I wish you a happy summer break and look forward to seeing students return to us on Tuesday 5th September.

### Local Groups Secure Big Lottery Funding

Local groups have recently secured Awards for All funding.

Brackenhall Community Trust have recently secured a £10,000 grant for new tables and chairs and funding towards some decorating at Northfield Hall which recently celebrated its 5<sup>th</sup> anniversary. The funding will refresh the centre.

Chestnut Nursery has secured £9,960 towards new equipment for the outdoor space used by the children in the downstairs nursery. The space is also used by the Out of School and Holiday Clubs. The grant will provide new equipment which will significantly enhance the space and importantly the learning and development of the children attending.

modular building for the site. The building will include community spaces and changing facilities. The group are just awaiting planning permission before they order the new building.



Chestnut LIC has now moved into new space within the Chestnut Centre. The relocation and downsizing of the LIC, is due to the original cuts in the Council budgets for supporting LIC's. Unfortunately, at this point we only have limited funding guaranteed until the end of March 2018. The Council have announced further cuts in Library funding in the future and this may well impact on the Chestnut Centre provision. Ashbrow Partnering Together, Local Services 2 You and the ward councillors are all working hard to try and maintain a service at the Chestnut Centre as they understand the importance of this facility for the local community.




# ARE YOU ASTHMATIC?

School holidays will soon be over and a new year at school will be starting. It is vital to make sure you have enough reliever inhalers to keep one on you at all times. This ensures a fast response in the case of an asthma attack. It is important that you are up to date with your Asthma Reviews. If not, please make an appointment with your Asthma Nurse to ensure there are no delays in getting your inhalers and that your treatment is correct. Without the fast use of a reliever a mild asthma attack can become fatal. THINK CAN I ACT FAST !!



## DO YOU HAVE ENOUGH INHALERS FOR SCHOOL?



Flu season is fast approaching and if you are taking a steroid inhaler or have any other long term conditions you may be eligible for the annual flu vaccination. If you are aged between 2yrs and 17yrs you may be able to have the nasal spray vaccine. This is a simple spray up each nostril. Asthma causes your airways to become swollen and sensitive. Getting flu causes more swelling and makes your airways even more sensitive. This can make your asthma symptoms worse and increase your risk of a potentially life threatening asthma attack. Getting the flu vaccine creates antibodies in your body that protect you from that particular type of flu, so if you do come across the virus your body will be prepared to fight it off. No vaccine is 100% effective, but people who have had the flu jab are less likely to get flu. If you do get flu when you've had the jab, it will probably be milder than if you hadn't been vaccinated.

## Don't bin your Household Enquiry Form – here's why

From the 17<sup>th</sup> July 2017 we will be sending out the Household Enquiry Forms to all homes in Kirklees.

Even if nothing has changed you **DO** need to respond. It's easy enough to let us know – you can do it online, by telephone, by text message or by post.

If you don't respond you may not be able to vote in elections. It may also affect your chances of getting a mobile phone contract, a mortgage or even opening a bank account. If there is anyone over 16 in the household who is not on the form, let us know, so that they won't be missing out!

Individual Electoral Registration means that every individual is personally responsible for being on the electoral register. Government rules mean you could be fined £1,000 if you don't respond.



## Can Care Navigation make a difference for you?

The Care Navigation team at Kirklees Council helps adults with social care needs, or their carers, find health and social care support in their communities.

Care Navigators have their own areas to work in so have a good local knowledge of what's available in communities, such as lunch clubs, social groups, exercise groups and support groups. They work with people to help them find support with their day to day lives including equipment, shopping, transport and cleaning. They can support people to find organisations that can advise on debt problems, benefits and housing, and more!

Care Navigators can help people to build a support package that is tailored to their needs. Support can come from health care providers, sports and leisure facilities or from voluntary and community groups. They can help people find free or alternative support, as well as care services for people who have a budget to spend.

Care Navigators can support people and their carers who have had an assessment of their needs, who are eligible for a personal budget, to arrange their own personalised support to enhance the quality of their lives. They can also help people decide how they want to spend their personal budget, if they would like Kirklees to provide their support, or if a direct payment would suit them better. Direct payments would allow them to choose their own provider or maybe employ a personal assistant. The team can provide the same advice and support to help people who decide not to have an assessment and want to pay for their own support to arrange the support that they want, using their specialised knowledge of what is available.




